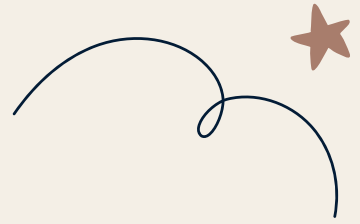
MISSION AND VISION

HEALTH

MATEO

SUPPORTED BY AYUDA A CORAZÓN DE NIÑO

At the Solmar Foundation, we know that access to specialized medical care can be the difference between uncertainty and hope. For that reason, we collaborate closely with **Ayuda a Corazón de Niño**, an organization that has walked alongside families on their children's recovery journey since 2001. They raise awareness of symptoms, identify potential heart conditions, provide timely diagnoses, prepare patients for treatment, perform highly specialized procedures, and offer follow-up care throughout the recovery process.

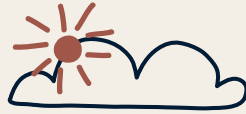
Mateo is one of the little hearts now beating strongly thanks to this comprehensive support. Diagnosed with a heart murmur at birth, he spent a year without sufficient medical checkups and was eventually discharged without cardiology follow-up. Fortunately, a doctor later realized something was wrong and urged his parents to contact Ayuda a Corazón de Niño.

After a specialized evaluation, doctors confirmed that Mateo had a congenital heart defect known as an Atrial Septal Defect (ASD), which required open-heart surgery. From that point forward, his parents received step-by-step guidance throughout the entire process.

In 2024, Mateo successfully underwent surgery. Just one month later, his family received the joyful news they had been waiting for: he is now more active than ever. He plays and runs without tiring, has reached a healthy weight, and is happily attending kindergarten.

His story reminds us that when we join forces to provide timely medical care, we do more than save lives; we transform futures.





HEALTH

FLOR, ROCÍO, AND ALDIER SUPPORTED BY AMIGOS DE LOS NIÑOS

At the Solmar Foundation, we believe that access to healthcare should never depend on circumstance. That is why we partner with **Amigos de los Niños**, an organization that has provided quality medical care to children and adolescents in Los Cabos for over 30 years. These young patients often have no other means of receiving care or lack adequate health coverage. Amigos de los Niños provides vital services, including outpatient care, specialized clinics, and assistance in developing treatment plans for severe or disabling conditions.

Flor, Rocío, and Aldier live on a remote ranch in northern Baja California Sur. To access medical care, their family embarks on a journey that takes a total of 12 hours. Their trip begins on muleback, traveling along rugged paths, and continues by bus until they reach the clinics.

Every member of the family lives with hearing loss. Through the support of Amigos de los Niños, they have gained access to specialized care. One of the most meaningful moments of this story was witnessing Flor and Rocío hear for the first time. This breakthrough was more than a medical milestone; it opened new doors for communication, learning, and growth.

Twice a year, they undertake this long journey, reminding us that when strong support networks and shared hope exist, no distance is too great to transform a life.

MARCELINO SUPPORTED BY BUILDING BAJA'S FUTURE

In 2025, the Solmar Foundation strengthened its commitment to education by supporting **Building Baja's Future (BBF)**, an organization dedicated to empowering young people to build brighter futures for themselves and their communities.

Marcelino, a proud Chinantec speaker from an Indigenous community in Oaxaca, discovered a life-changing opportunity through BBF's scholarship program. While he had always dreamed of becoming a writer, the guidance and support he received inspired him to pursue a law degree instead.

Currently, he serves as a technical advisor for the XV Los Cabos City Council, practicing his profession with integrity and a strong sense of service. Marcelino acknowledges that the support he received not only helped him complete his university education but also instilled in him a lasting commitment to the well-being of his community.

His story demonstrates that investing in education opens doors to new opportunities and creates a positive impact on young people for generations to come.

To support the well-being of older adults, the Solmar Foundation provides monthly food packages to the members of **Casa de Día** para el Adulto Mayor, helping to enhance their nutrition and improve their overall quality of life.

María, a participant at the center, shares that this support has significantly impacted her health. Since she began receiving nutritious food through the monthly distributions, she has noticed a marked improvement in her well-being. Recent medical tests have shown favorable results, reflecting the vital role that consistent, balanced nutrition has played in her long-term wellness.

For María, this support means more than just food; it provides peace of mind, care, and the opportunity to navigate this stage of life with dignity, hope, and a proactive focus on her health.

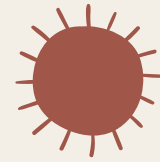

In April 2024, Juan Carlos reached a significant milestone that marked a turning point in his life: he completed his cancer treatment. 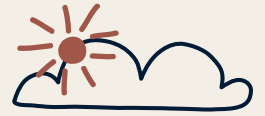


TOTAL INDIVIDUALS SUPPORTED

AMIGOS DE LOS NIÑOS

Provides specialized medical, dental, and hearing care for children in Los Cabos.



ASOCIACIÓN DE LABIO Y PALADAR HENDIDO DE LOS CABOS

Offers comprehensive care for patients in Los Cabos with cleft lip and/or palate.



AYUDA A CORAZÓN DE NIÑO

Supports children and youth in Baja California Sur who have been diagnosed with congenital heart conditions.



COMUNIDAD AUTISMO DE LOS CABOS

Promotes early detection tools for ASD, diagnostic protocols, training for families, professional development for caregivers, and improvements in care models, as well as school and workplace inclusion programs.



SMILE TRAIN

Provides surgeries for children and teens in Baja California Sur born with cleft lip and/or palate, along with nutritional support, dental care, orthodontic treatment, speech therapy, and emotional support.



LÍNEA DE VIDA

A nonprofit organization supporting low-income men and women in Baja California Sur who have been diagnosed with cancer. It offers comprehensive guidance and operates a shelter that provides lodging, meals, and orientation for patients traveling from distant communities to receive treatment.

CASA RAMÉ

Provides care and education for underprivileged children in Los Cabos, including those from single-parent households and working families with limited resources.

Offers sponsorship, mentorship, and community engagement to help create a future where every inspired, motivated, and talented student in Los Cabos has the opportunity to attend leading schools in Mexico and abroad, with the support of their community every step of the way.



NUTRITION



CASA DE DÍA

Operates as a daytime center for adults over 60, providing nutritious meals along with psychological support and occupational therapy services from Monday through Friday.

FAMILY WELFARE



CASA VALENTINA

Provides lodging and meals along with psychological and occupational therapies for pediatric patients and their caregivers. Located just steps from Hospital Salvatierra in La Paz, Baja California Sur, this facility supports families of children undergoing oncology or cardiology treatment, as well as those in pediatric and neonatal intensive care.
