### SUPPORT FOR AYUDA A CORAZÓN DE NIÑO A.C.

Helps children and youth in Baja California Sur who have been diagnosed with congenital heart conditions.



### SUPPORT FOR AMIGOS DE LOS NIÑOS A.C.

Provides quality medical care for children and teens in Los Cabos who otherwise wouldn't have access to adequate services.



### SUPPORT FOR CASA RAMÉ A.C.

Improves the quality of life for individuals with disabilities while encouraging their participation in society, education, and the workforce.



### SUPPORT FOR CASA VALENTINA DIF

A shelter that offers housing, meals, psychological support, and occupational therapy to children undergoing oncology treatments.



### SUPPORT FOR LOS NIÑOS DEL CAPITÁN A.C.

An institution dedicated to educating children from low-income households, especially those raised by single parents.



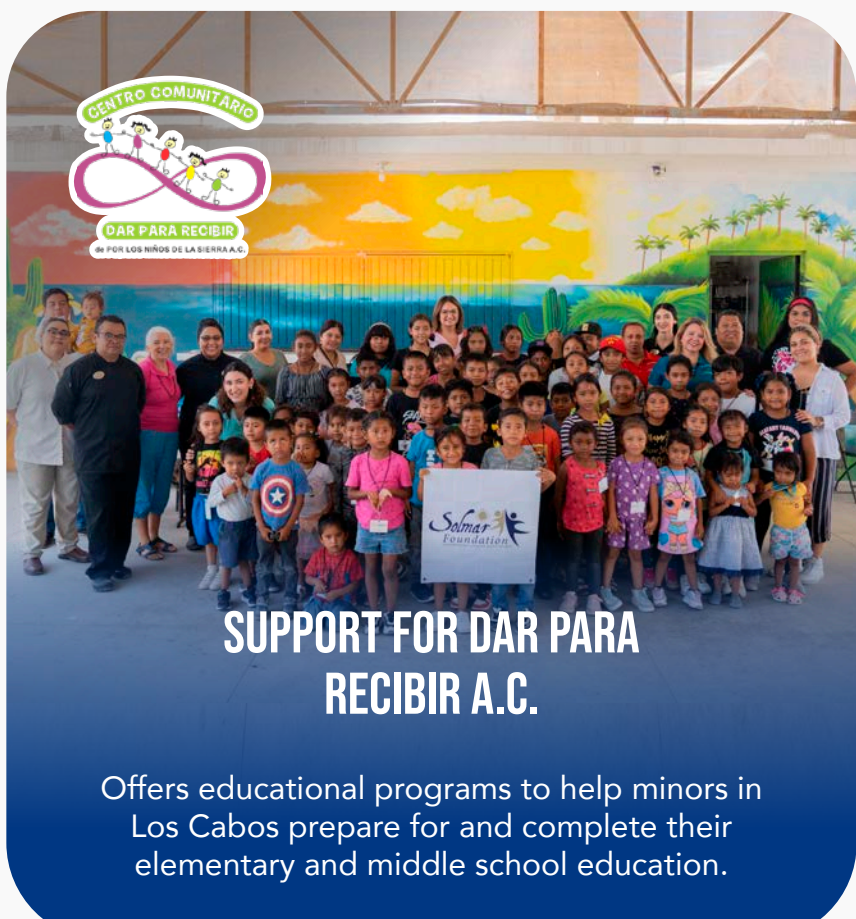
### SUPPORT FOR BUILDING BAJA'S FUTURE A.C.
